All the children are aware that 'planets' represent phonic sounds and 'earth' words are tricky words. We will learn to read and spell our Reading Rocket sets which match our phonic ability.
Physical Development	This term we will be developing our gross and fine motor skills through 'Dance Write'. We will learn large movements and actions which transfer onto paper as early handwriting patterns.
History	This week we will be exploring 'toys over time'. We will be matching toys for different ages to them - baby / toddler / child - link to birthday as a key event.

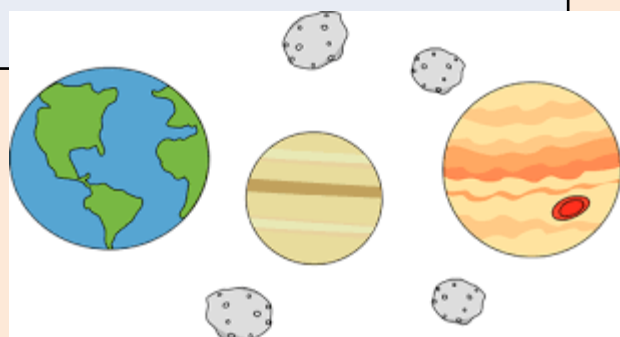
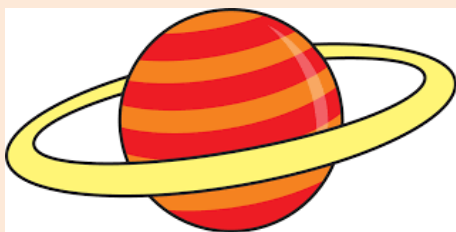

Art	We will be exploring the skill of sculpting and joining. We will learn about different joins and ways to join, before joining with a purpose in mind using different tools.
Physical Development	This term we will be developing our gross and fine motor skills through 'Dance Write'. We will learn large movements and actions which transfer onto paper as early handwriting patterns.
Understanding the world – Science	We will continue to explore our five senses, focusing this week on the sense of touch. We will be using our sense of touch to explore different materials.
