



These are the new phonic sounds that you will meet in this set of books and the graphemes that represent them.


Remember, some of these graphemes will appear as capital letters, if they are used in names or to start sentences.
















There are some words that cannot be fully sounded out and decoded yet.


We call these 'Earth Words'!


Some of these words will start with capital letters if they are used to start sentences.















Top Pap can assist!

Top Pap stops the drip and mops up! 0000






Min sips pop and drops the can!




Top Pap spots Min! Top Pap is mad!

Top Pip gets a peg and pops the sock up.










Gop the pig gets muck on the rug.


Top Pip pops the pig in the pen.





Top Pip and Top Pap go to get Doc.








Parent and child activity
