Dear Parents,

As you will be aware, the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check will begin on the week commencing Monday 12th June 2023. It is designed to show how well children can use their decoding and phonics skills they have learned, and to help identify any pupils who may need extra support with their reading.

The screening is nothing to worry about at all – it takes approximately five minutes to deliver. Each child is asked to read 40 words to a member of staff known to the child. 20 of the words are pseudo words, or 'alien words', that children need to sound out and blend to show they understand the phonics rules. These words have an alien next to them, to highlight that these are words with no meaning. Children are well used to this from our everyday classroom practise.

Children then have a further 20 words to read, that are familiar words, such as 'coin', 'spring', 'charming', 'bowl', 'saucer', 'trapeze' and 'concrete'.

The 'pass mark' is not made available to teachers at this stage, though traditionally has been set at 32 out of 40. Children who do not meet the threshold will need to resit the screening at the end of Year 2.

We teach phonics and reading every day in school, so your child will be well practised in the skills of sounding out and blending to read unfamiliar words.

However, if you would like any extra practise materials, please ask your child's class teacher for resources. We have many 'booster' sheets designed for target practise on particular grapheme-phoneme correspondences (letters and the sounds they make). Your child's "Reading Rockets" booklet also provides lists of words for practise. As always, regular reading at home will also support your child with their decoding skills.

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
